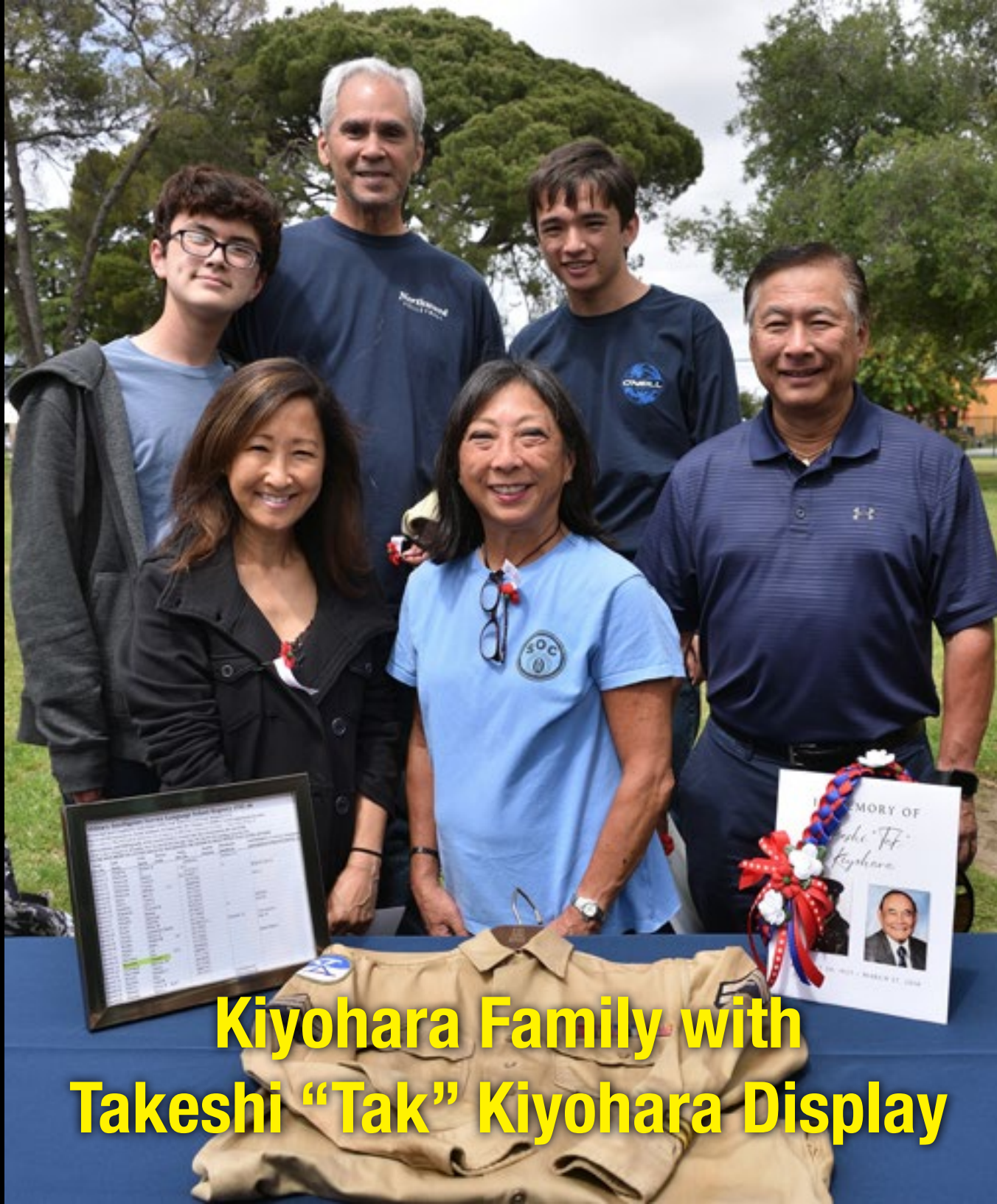
Kenji Joe Otsuka enlisted in the United States Army in 1943 at the age of 31.
 He was stationed at Fort Snelling, Minnesota for basic training.
 Upon completion of basic training he was transferred to Camp Koenig, Minnesota to begin his training for the Military Intelligence Service (MIS). He completed his training at Fort Snelling, Minnesota. During his stay at Fort Snelling, he placed himself for the Fort Snelling team, which competed against other military units.
 Upon the completion of his training in 1945, he was sent to Japan to be part of the MIS. He was able to visit Okinawa and the Philippines as part of the Army Exchange Team.
 He met his future wife, Diane, while he was stationed at Fort Snelling, Minnesota.
 Kenji Joe Otsuka was honorably discharged from the United States Army in 1946.

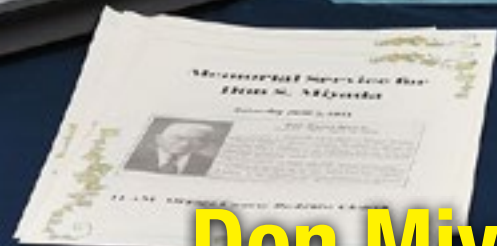

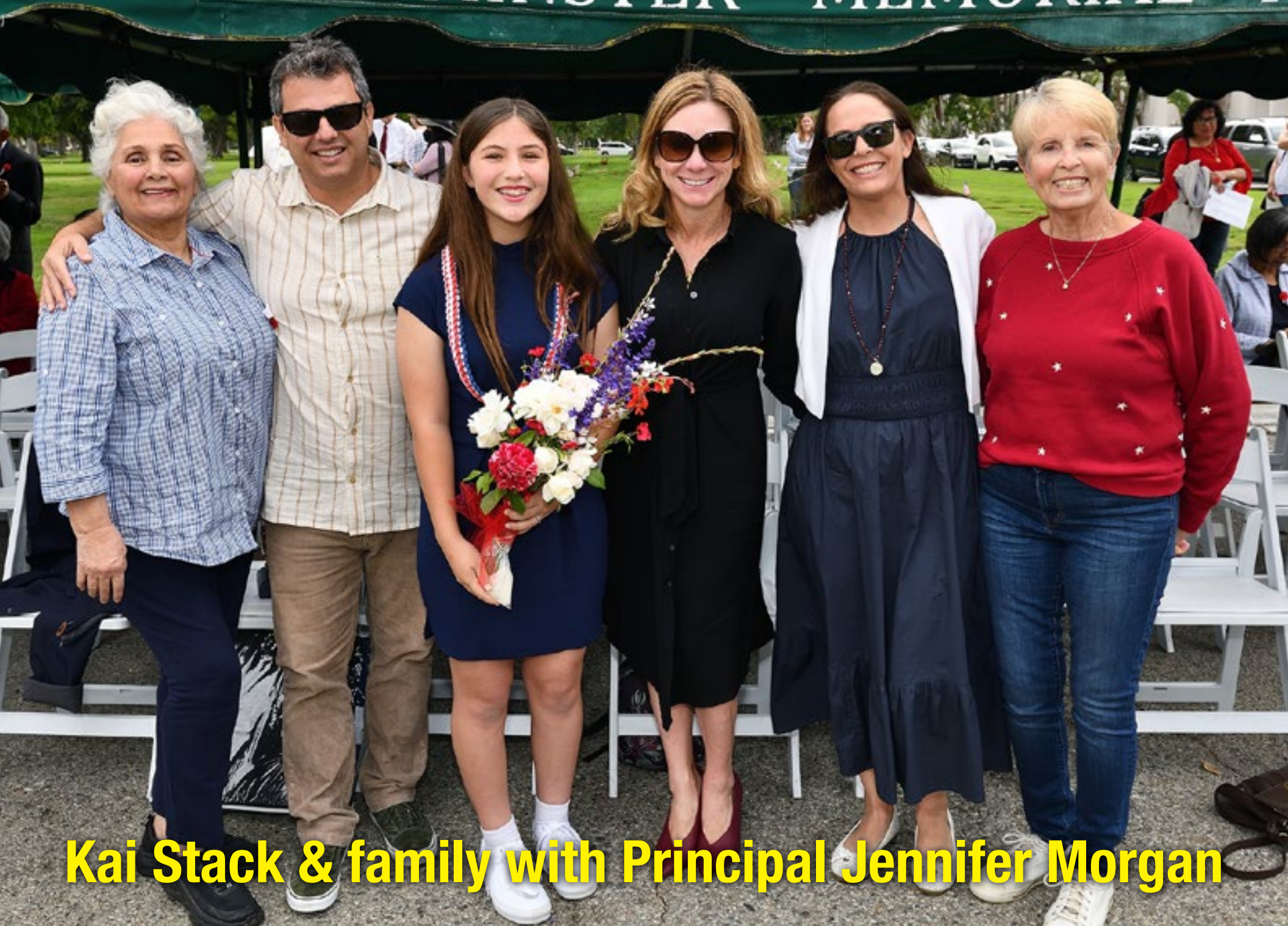
